# FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

## ABOUT LESSONS



- QUESTION:** My child is a beginner level student. Can they study in this program?  
**ANSWER:** No problem. We welcome students at all levels.
- QUESTION:** My child is unsure. Can we apply for a shorter study period first and extend after starting the course?  
**ANSWER:** Yes, your child can extend their studies after starting the course if there is still capacity to accommodate them.
- QUESTION:** Can we shorten the length of the study period if my child isn't enjoying the course?  
**ANSWER:** Yes, however, the tuition fee is non-refundable after the course begins.
- QUESTION:** Am I able to enrol in an English course while my child attends the program?  
**ANSWER:** Yes, you can. We hope you will both have a valuable learning experience with us at EU.
- QUESTION:** Is there any age limit for studying as an adult? I'm a grandparent.  
**ANSWER:** There is no age limit in any of our courses.
- QUESTION:** My child will study for 3 weeks. Can I attend English lessons for just a week?  
**ANSWER:** Yes. You don't need to study for the same length as your child.

## ABOUT ACTIVITIES



- QUESTION:** Can I join the activities with my child?  
**ANSWER:** We welcome parents. However, fees associated with the activities will be charged.
- QUESTION:** What do we need to bring for the activities?  
**ANSWER:** This is dependent on the weather and the places we visit. We recommend comfortable shoes, water, sunscreen, hat and an umbrella.

## ABOUT ACCOMMODATION



- QUESTION:** I will travel with my 14 year old son and 7 year old daughter and we would like to experience the Australian lifestyle. Can we apply for homestay?  
**ANSWER:** We can arrange a homestay for your family. We recommend a homestay with 1 single room for your son and 1 twin share room for you and your daughter.
- QUESTION:** My child has some allergies to animals and food restrictions. Can you find a homestay host that can accommodate this?  
**ANSWER:** Yes, please list your child's conditions on the homestay application form and we will endeavour to find a suitable host family.
- QUESTION:** Can we stay in a homestay but arrange our own food?  
**ANSWER:** We can arrange a self-catering homestay where you can cook for yourself in a kitchen.
- QUESTION:** My child will study for 4 weeks, however we need to stay for 5 weeks because of our flights. Is it possible to stay longer than the course length?  
**ANSWER:** Yes, you can stay for a longer or shorter period than your course.
- QUESTION:** We have heard that homestays are located in the suburbs and we may need to travel for an hour or so by public transport. Is that true?  
**ANSWER:** Yes, most Australian families live in the suburbs. The average travelling time between homestays and the college is about 1 hour.
- QUESTION:** Will you be able to change my child's homestay if they are unhappy with anything?  
**ANSWER:** Yes. We would like you to feel at ease and let us know about any issues that concern you.

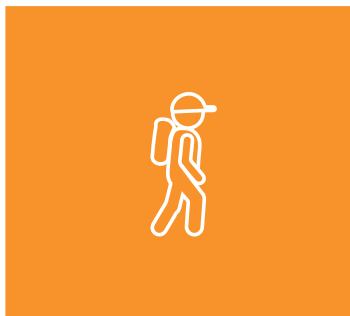
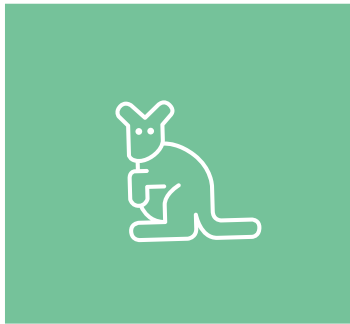
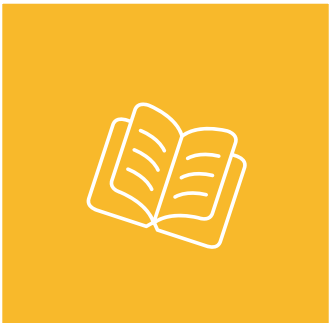
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
